

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CONSULTANT ADVISOR

National Institute of Animal Biotechnology desires to engage a Consultant Advisor, initially for a period of 1 year for development and mentoring of the research outreach programmes of NIAB. The educational qualifications, scope of work and consultation fee are given below:-

1. Qualifications:

Professional having a Ph.D. degree in Life sciences and minimum post qualification experience of 30 years in the requisite field. Government employees who (i) retired in the Grade pay of Rs.10,000/- & above, and (ii) has at least 25 years experience in the required field would also be eligible for this position.

2. Experience:

- Fostering collaboration with local, regional and international institutions.
- Coordination of multi-disciplinary research teams involved in Animal Genetics and genomics, Animal reproduction and breeding and Animal health.
- Experience in dealing R&D as well as industrial projects & time bound implementation of the programmes.
- Working experience in International Organisations.

3. Scope of Work: As per terms of reference at Annexure-1.

4. Consultation Fee:

Consolidated fee shall range from Rs. 60,000/- to Rs. 90,000/- depending up on educational qualification and experience.

No other allowance such as DA / HRA etc. would be admissible.

NOTE: The amount of fee in case of retired Government official's appointment as Consultant shall be fixed at the last pay drawn plus DA at rate prevailing on the date of appointment as Consultant less basic pension /pension equivalent of employer's contribution to CPF, subject to the maximum fee indicated above.

5. Age limit: 65 years

6. No other benefits such as CPF, LTC and Medical Benefits etc. would be admissible.

7. The appointment is purely temporary and can be terminated at any time without assigning any reason.

Terms of Reference**SCOPE OF WORK:**

NIAB has initiated a number of endeavours for institutional collaborations both nationally and internationally for furthering the mandate of the Institute. The functioning of such institutional collaborations requires synergistic actions and processes that would promote connectivity within the collaborating Institutions. The Consultant Advisor would be required to co-ordinate the institutional process and their harmonization required for the success of complex research outreach efforts. She/he shall work closely with NIAB and its collaborating organizations and guide/provide strategic operational advice to achieve the research objectives. The duties include, among others, developing and coordinating dialogue between all stakeholders, and facilitating the evolution of the structure and governance of institutional collaborations. She/he will be expected to take the initiative in developing stakeholder networks relevant for livestock health and productivity, and in the creation and execution of strategies for brand development of NIAB's research out reach. The job requires an overarching role in moulding animal biotechnology programmes. Also to co-ordinate the activities for academic research and human resource development in collaboration with national and international institutes in the areas of quantitative genetics and genomics. Consultant Advisor shall also be expected to co-ordinate establishment of a collaborative Centre in the area of animal genetics and breeding and Technology Business Incubator.
